

Dear Parents

We hope you have had a lovely half-term break with family and friends and have enjoyed the Jubilee celebrations. We begin this half term with International Week when the children will be learning about England and, in particular, London. Some of the activities will include building bridges to replicate Tower Bridge as well as building homes and palaces. Our role play will replicate a visit through London on a bus seeing the beautiful sites. We will play some typically British sports and pretend to run the London marathon! During the week, we shall enjoy traditional British foods and make sandwiches and enjoy strawberries and ice cream. We will also make a Victoria sponge crown cake! We will end the week on Friday with fish and chips! If your child would like fish and chips on Friday 10th June, they will not need a packed lunch on this day.

The weeks to follow will continue to be themed around holidays and travel.
